ESMA Aviation Academy Signs Agreement with CAFUC

ESMA Aviation Academy has signed a new contract to train flight attendant and maintenance technician students of the Civil Aviation Flight University of China (CAFUC). This new contract is in addition to the five-year agreement the two companies signed in 2009 for ESMA to train 100 CAFUC pilots per year.

ESMA will offer a comprehensive and customised eight-week program for flight attendants at ESMA Montpellier and ESMA Paris Training Centres that is compliant with the European program and includes additional training modules such as an English reinforcement course and a customer services module with French standards.

For maintenance technicians, ESMA Montpellier will provide Licence Part B1.1 (Aeroplane Jet Engines) to the CAFUC students. This complete training based under European regulations will take about a year and a half (78 weeks).
